### Colorado Uninsured Rate One of the Lowest in the Nation


Colorado is one of the leaders in the US when it comes to our uninsured population. In a recent survey completed by the Colorado Health Institute, Colorado is currently at a historically low uninsured rate of 6.7%—down from 14.3% in 2013. According to the survey, Colorado has the 27th lowest uninsured rate in the US and is above the national average.

Colorado has been particularly effective in expanding coverage for people in the Exchange. With the expansion of Medicaid in Colorado, 450,000 people have been enrolled over the last two years and it is estimated that one in five Colorado residents are now on Medicaid.

In addition, the survey gathered information on the overall views of Colorado's healthcare system—nearly 75 percent of those surveyed say the current system meets the needs of their family.
