The 2024 Nightingale awards recognize nurses in nine categories with additional subcategories including: Acute Care Clinical Practice, Clinical Advanced Practice RN, Long Term Care, Rehabilitation, Community Nursing, Nurse Led Teams, Nursing Administration, Research and Quality Improvement and Health Care Policy, Nursing Education and Excellence in Nursing Eminence Award. By structuring the program in this manner, many more nurses are being recognized for excellence in nursing in Colorado.

The Nightingale Award for Excellence in Human Caring was founded in 1985 to honor nurses who best exemplify the philosophy and practice of Florence Nightingale, a 19th century nursing pioneer who epitomized the art of caring. For nearly forty years, registered nurses throughout Colorado have been nominated by peers, supervisors, friends and family for this prestigious award. This regional event recognizes and honors western Colorado nominees and finalists.
