Dear Community Members,

As we look back on 2025, I'm reminded that the heart of healthcare isn't found in buildings, technology or systems. It's found in the relationships we build with our patients, families and community.

The past year brought both challenges and opportunities for healthcare, particularly for rural communities. At Moab Regional Hospital, our focus has remained simple: put people first and make care as accessible, compassionate, and trustworthy as possible.

Our 2025 Community Health Needs Assessment helped us better understand what matters most to the people we serve. Four priorities rose to the top: **mental and behavioral health, access to primary and specialty care, senior care, and workforce and community trust.**

These priorities are helping guide our work. In 2025, we expanded access to care close to home by bringing specialty providers to visit and expanded services such as Wound Care. We strengthened mental and behavioral health services, with more than 350 people actively engaged in treatment at our Recovery Center and more than 3,500 patient visits. We also expanded our Medicare Annual Wellness Program to help more local seniors stay healthy and independent. We continued investing in our employees and building partnerships across the community—both essential to maintaining the care our community depends on.

Our Community Benefits Report offers a look at some of that work, along with the people and programs behind it. Most of all, it reflects something that doesn't always show up in numbers or statistics: the commitment of the people who care for this community every day.

Thank you for trusting Moab Regional Hospital with your health and for sharing your ideas about what our community needs. We're grateful for the opportunity to serve you, and we look forward to continuing this work together.
